Rovos Rail

There are three cabin types to choose from, ranging from the smaller Pullman suites to the 16m² Royal Suites, each complete with private en-suite bathrooms. Routes offered include the popular Cape Town to Pretoria (v.v) 2-night journey, Pretoria to Durban (v.v), overnight Cape Town to George, as well as the epic Cape Town to Dar-Es-Salaam 13 day journey which travels through Zimbabwe at Victoria Falls and Zambia, stopping at various locations en-route.

The Blue Train

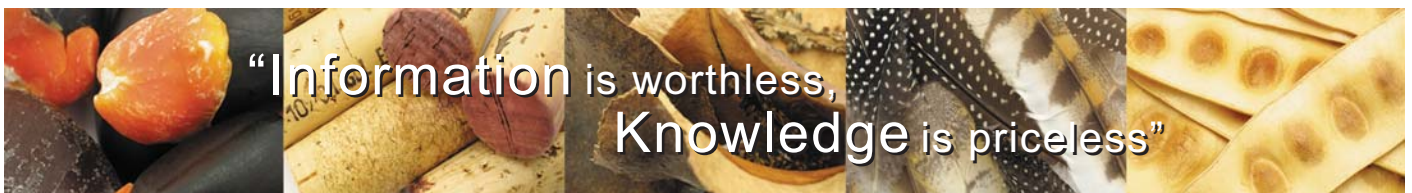
