Day 2:

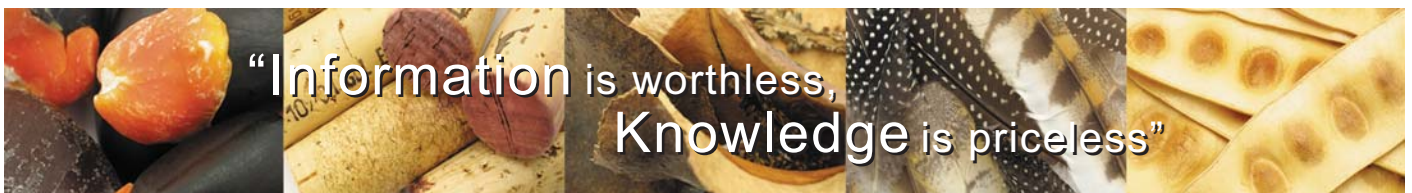
The journey continues through ever changing landscapes. Border control formalities take place on either side of the border before you continue through towards South Africa via Zimbabwe and Botswana.

Day 4:

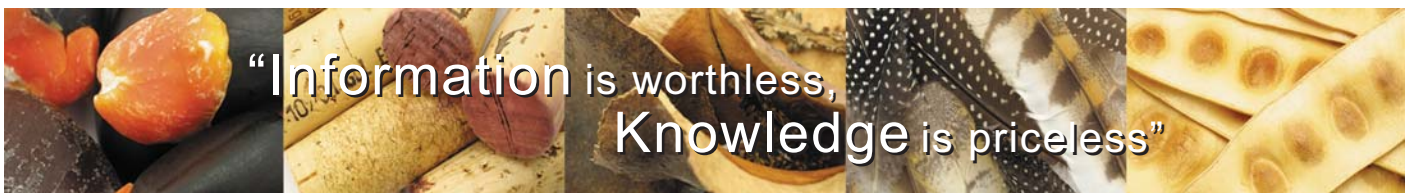
